Dear Valued Guests,

Recently as you are maybe aware, the Maldives has experienced severe storms, unfortunately our Seawall at the far end of Play Island was badly affected by these weather events that are beyond our control and requires urgent attention to avoid tidal damage to our beach. With the interest of protecting the specific beach area affected, we will initiate an emergency rehabilitation work that will be extend for three weeks duration commencing on the 10th November 2021.

To rehabilitate the area within a very short time, we inform you that we required support of heavy machinery that will be visible to guests at the far end of the Play Island, every effort will be made to minimize the impact on guests in this area and a strict schedule will be followed to avoid noisy works at unreasonable times. Rest assured that we will be operating as usual, without any disruption to any other services or facilities

We do apologise for the late notice regarding these works; however, we had not anticipated the damage caused by these storms, extreme weather and sea conditions. We consider the works emergency as any further delay would result in damage to the beach area.
